We've had another busy month with activities and social events. Denis and Lorri are keeping our full-time residents busy, and all seem to be enjoying everything they have going on. The biggest event we had this past month was the visit by Sunshine Water management. We had over 100 residents attend this townhall with Dominic Gentilucci, Vice President of Strategic Operations for the West Coast and South Florida, Bobby Tedder, Sunshine Strategic Communications, Lee Neal, Area Manager, and Jeff Lambert, FLE Lead Operator. They covered the following areas:

- Water Quality: Florida is 100% well
 water and the quality of water can
 change from area to area. The 2023
 Water Quality Report was disseminated
 in early June and can be found on
 MyUtilityConnect.com. They passed all
 tests required by the Florida
 Department of Environmental
 Protection (DEP) for both the water and
 treatment facility. If you want soft water,
 then you need to install a water
 softener.
- Sulfur Smell: One of their recirculation pumps went down in March/April and they installed a new pump, odor blockers, and are conducting daily inspection of all pumps.

- 3. Water Rates: They are increasing due to the cost of supplies, capital investments, chemical costs, and electricity costs and all this must be passed on to the customers. They will be making a \$3-5M investment in our treatment facility in the next year or so.
- 4. Billing: the bills in April went out 10 days late due to an issue with the contractor. The issue was resolved, and bills went out on June 17th. You can always go online to see your bills and raise any issues you may have.
- 5. Future Upgrades: installing an emergency generator at the water plant; improving quality of operations; putting new covers on open tanks; and improving odor controls.
- 6. Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI): AMI is a new smart metering system that provides remote meter reading capabilities. The benefits of AMI are: detection of leaks and customer notifications through My Utility Account; highly accurate data collection; online access so customers can monitor and manage their water usage in real time; and reduces operating cost for meter reading and billing, ultimately improving customer service. AMI should be remote ready by the end of 2024.
- 7. Damaged Water Covers: If your cover is damaged, call Sunshine and put in a complaint. Jeff Lambert will install a new one. Call 866-842-8432 and you will be directed to the emergency dispatch.

The meeting was extremely informative and went very well. The Sunshine Management Team announced they will come back in January 2025 when our park is full of all our northerners. They will do a presentation on the AMI water metering system and answer any issues/concerns we may have.
