# A message from Jim Dill

What a month this has been. I want to first welcome back many of our family and friends who are starting to come home from their summers up north. We have jam packed calendars with tons of activities and social events on tap. Be alert for our Robocalls, Sunday Bulletin emails, and our monthly calendars in the Happenings newsletter.

On October 9th, Hurricane Milton made landfall about 90 miles away in Siesta Key and we were on the north side which had all the high winds and heavy rain. We got over 20 inches of rain, and I think the winds exceeded 100 MPH. Many residents left the park, but many of us stayed. The rains started Tuesday night, and everything had ended by Thursday morning. It sounded like a freight train was coming through our homes all night long. You could also hear the metal ripping off roofs and landing all over the park. When we all went outside on Thursday morning, there was a lot of heavy damage. I would guess we had about 20% of our homes damaged with minor to major damage. Spring Lake Dr. and Bream Circle both had extensive flooding. We also had several streets in the park closed because of downed trees.

Several residents went to work immediately before ELS even came back to the park. There are too many to recognize, but two that come

to mind are Steve Bushey and Chris Hutchens. They got out there with Steve's chainsaw and started cutting the trees so that residents could get out of the park. If you see them around, please give them a hearty thank you!

We had lots of damage but none of our homes were completely blown away, showing that our tie downs do indeed work. We will be getting info out shortly on the Florida grant to have new tie downs installed. There is about a 2 year backlog but we need to get into the queue. Vickie and her team have done a great job getting cleanup efforts underway and are working as quickly as possible to return our community to pre-storm conditions. The downed trees and several others, about 17, will be removed by a tree contractor. If you are concerned with a tree or limbs that look like they may come down, please contact the office directly and let the HOA board know so we can follow-up with them. The park is getting back to looking good. They still have limbs, trees and metal to pick up. The main entrance gate repairs are going to contract soon; the outdoor fitness canopy has been approved but office is waiting for the contractor to get approved; they have one bid for the sunshades over the patio and waiting on a second bid; they are replacing the door on the putt putt shed; and the pools were cleaned, and the heaters have been repaired. I know it is taking a while but remember that our entire area was damaged or flooded and it's taking some time to get contractors in the park. Much of the region had considerably more damage and flooding than we had. Please tell Vickie and her maintenance team thanks for all they are doing.

We have several events in November that I hope you all can come out to support. An important one for our vets is on November 11, our annual Veterans Day Ceremony to say thanks to all our Vets for their service to our great country. We will follow this with a spaghetti dinner free for all our Vets and a minimal charge for family and






