Message from the Desk of Rick Schlager

The month of September has been a quiet one with temperatures in the low 90's each day. The rain has settled down after our near miss with hurricane Dorian. It is starting to get into a more seasonal trend of lower humidity.



A number of things have been happening in the community:

- Currently workmen are repairing some of the sidewalks. Stewart and Peggy have identified the most urgent sidewalk areas that need repair.
- The company that installed the aerators in the lake came in and repaired the compressors at both dock locations. There are two compressors at each dock that operate a total of 16 aerators. The aerators did provide some benefit to the lake by keeping the water moving, reducing algae levels and providing much needed oxygen for the fish.
- Peggy is still getting bids for some of the projects ELS wants to accomplish in anticipation of the new homes in the front of F.L.E. We will update everyone as we get more information of their timeframe.

The board met in early September to fill an empty board seat. Mike Black was appointed to the board for the next 3 months. Mike will need to run again in December for a three-year seat on the board.

Mark Matthews is getting a team together to update the Memorial Park with new plants and mulch. Volunteers will participate on Saturday September 21st and teams will be given a section to plant and spread bark mulch. We want to have this completed for the return of our residents and be ready for Veterans Day which is just around the corner.

A big THANK YOU to Karen Brown and all she and her culinary helpers do in the kitchen to make delicious meals, soups & desserts for a very reasonable price. If you haven't been you need to come out and have a great meal and socialize with friends.

AdventHealth Teams Up to Provide Free Flu Shots and Hepatitis A Vaccines

AdventHealth Zephyrhills and AdventHealth Dade City are partnering with the Florida Department of Health in Pasco County to provide free immunizations to keep you and your loved ones well and feeling whole throughout the year.

Plan to attend our clinic for your complimentary flu vaccine on Thursday, October 24, from noon to 5 pm, at the East Pasco Seventh-day Adventist Church, 7333 Dairy Road, Zephyrhills. If you'd like, you can also receive the first of two Hepatitis A immunizations. However, you'll need to go to the nearest Pasco County Department of Health six months later, in April 2020, to get your second and last Hepatitis A immunization. This second shot will also be free.

No insurance is required, and Canadian residents are welcome. Immunizations will be provided on a first come, first serve basis.

If you can't make the Zephyrhills clinic, we're offering a second one with the same immunizations on Saturday, October 26, from 8 am to noon at the Dade City Senior Center, 13853 15th Street, Dade City. Again, this clinic is free, and no reservations will be taken.

AdventHealth would like to thank the Pasco County Department of Health for the immunizations, and the East Pasco Seventh-day Adventist Church and the Dade City Senior Center for donating space for these important community events.

Pumpkin Carving/Decorating Rules:


- Teams of three to participate. If you don't have a team, we will team you up with other single participants on the day of the event.

- Winners will be announced at 4:00 PM


If carving or dressing up is not your thing, we will also have a Halloween coloring station available for you. The point is to join us for a **FUN** time.


